



## Who is eligible for care at New Bern Ridge Family Dental Center?

New Bern Ridge Family Dental Center provides dental services for children. We welcome children ages 1 – 18 to our Dental Center.

We provide limited services to adults, and only those adults who have been patients of our medical practices for more than a year.

- Hours are 8a-6p Monday through Thursday, with limited morning appointments for adult patients referred from our medical practices.
- Adults referred from one of the Wake Health Services medical practices must already be a current and permanent patient and have utilized the medical practice for more than one year.
- Unfortunately, our dental practice does not see adult patients from outside medical practices. If you are over 18 years of age, and have an emergency dental need, your options are:
  - an urgent care center,
  - one of the three area hospital emergency rooms,
